

IDEA League grant – Introduction and Requirements

Introduction

The IDEA League invites the students of its partner universities to apply for funding for joint projects of the study associations.

Collaboration within the IDEA League is based on the concept of added value by pooling our resources for the creation of unique and integrated programmes. Joint activities of the students are an important bottom-up aspect of our cooperation process.

General information

We welcome any proposal that will contribute to stimulating and strengthening the cooperation between IDEA League partners. The amount of the grant is up to €3000,- for a project.

The Operational Board of the IDEA League decides which projects are awarded a grant. As the operational board meets only a limited number of times a year, applications should be handed in well in advance. There are two deadlines: 15 September and 15 March. The Application Form can be downloaded from the IDEA League website.

Requirements

The grants will be awarded based on the added value for the IDEA League:

- The proposed project has to include at least 3 of the 5 IDEA League partners and should be open to all IDEA League partners.
- The proposed project has to stimulate and strengthen cooperation between IDEA League partners.
- The proposed project has to have characteristics that facilitate a sustainable network in the future (in other words: will the project be of use after the event in terms of network, knowledge or further collaboration).

After the grant has been awarded, the IDEA League asks of the grant recipient that:

- The IDEA League will be mentioned in any type of promotional material (website, social media, flyers, etc.). If wanted, the IDEA League can help promote the event on the IDEA League's website, Facebook and Twitter.
- The grant recipient will send one or more photos and updates during the event to the IDEA League office for the IDEA League to post on Facebook and Twitter.
- After the event, the grant recipient will write a short review of the event and send it to the IDEA League office (template can be downloaded from the IDEA League website).
