Costs Overview

For each semester there are a number of standard costs you need to be aware of. Below you can find an outline of these costs. Note that this is just an estimate and your monthly costs may be different depending on your own personal choices. You will notice that some costs are listed but not included in the total fees. This is because the amount that could cover these costs just need to be shown in your bank account. These overviews are not all-inclusive: they may not include, for example, rent or costs for food or health insurance as these costs will depend on your personal situation.

^{**} The Living Costs per year is based on rules of the Dutch Immigration Service (IND). TU Delft will refund the amount needed to show on your bank about for Living Costs, after deducting the Residence Permit/VISA fee and/or Housing fee, into your SEPA bank account approximately three weeks after starting your study programme in Delft. While you will be in Delft for only 5 months, you have to pay the full amount for 12 months of study to get your visa/residence permit for study purposes. Your residence permit for the Netherlands should then be valid for the entirety of your programme. Thus, should you return to the Netherlands for your thesis with a valid residence card, you will not need to pay the living cost and/or residence permit fee again. The Living Cost should cover general costs of living such as housing, food and insurance. Please see the Dutch Study in Holland website for more information on daily costs of living.
