TU Delft will refund the Living Costs, after deducting the Residence Permit/VISA fee and/or Housing fee, into your SEPA bank account approximately three weeks after starting your study programme in Delft. While you will be in Delft for only 5 months, you have to pay the full amount for 12 months of study to get your visa/residence permit for study purposes. Your residence permit for the Netherlands should then be valid for the entirety of your programme. Thus should you return to the Netherlands for your thesis with a valid residence card, you will not need to pay the living cost and/or residence permit fee again.
